IMPACT Passes Both Houses of Congress

Last week both the House and the Senate passed the IMPACT Act and sent the bill to the President for signature. IMPACT provides the foundation for upcoming discussions on payment methodologies for

all post-acute providers, including nursing homes, home health, and rehabilitation facilities. Among the requirements of the Act:

- Integrate a standardized assessment tool across all post-acute providers and acute care hospitals for pressure ulcers, functional status, cognitive status and special services.
- > Develop public report of common quality measures, such as rehospitalization and pressure ulcers, across all post-acute settings.
- > Provide quality measures to consumers when deciding on a post acute provider.
- Conduct studies about a universal post-acute payment model.

A universal post acute assessment, quality measure and payment system across all settings has been discussed at various levels of government for over a decade. IMPACT firmly sets that direction for the federal government. Expect to hear more and more about the impact of IMPACT in the coming years.

Other News:

Anti-Psychotic Use for Dementia Decreases Nationwide; Less In Illinois

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) announced that between the end of 2011 and the end of 2013, the national prevalence of anti-psychotic medication use in long-stay nursing home residents with dementia decreased 23.8 percent of residents to 20.2 percent, a reduction of 15.1%, which was the announced goal of the CMS-sponsored National Partnership to Improve Dementia Care coalition. During the same time period Illinois reduced its anti-psychotic use for dementia residents by 6 percent (compared with 15 percent nationally), placing Illinois 49th in the nation with dementia anti-psychotic med reduction. The National Partnership – including the national provider associations - two weeks ago announced a new goal of reducing antipsychotic medication use in long-stay nursing home residents by 25 percent by the end of 2015 and 30 percent by the end of 2016. In the past year, additional mandatory training on the topic was provided to all surveyors – so continue to expect that anti-psychotic medication use with dementia residents will be an ongoing focus of certification surveys.

Resident Personal Need Allowance Increased to \$60 for DD and CILAs

The Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) released a memo this past week notifying providers of an increase of the personal need allowance for residents of ICF-DD facilities and Community Integrated Living Arrangements (CILAs) to \$60 a month, effective for dates of service starting September 1, 2014. Similar efforts have been unsuccessfully introduced annually in the legislature for more than two decades for residents of nursing homes, but have not passed because of the cost impact on the state budget (generally \$50 to \$80 million).

Reminder: Flu Vaccine Offerings Start October 1

By law and regulation, facilities are required to offer flu vaccinations from October 1 thru March 31 (with all existing residents offered the vaccine by November 30). They also require facilities to offer the pneumonia vaccine year round unless the resident has received it in the past five years or it is not against physician orders. Even if your facility is not enrolled in Medicare, it can still roster bill for administering the vaccine for residents who are Part B Medicare. Facilities who are enrolled in Medicare can also bill for the cost of the vaccine if the facility purchases the vaccine.
