Since January, 2020, facilities' operations have been affected, rightly or wrongly, by guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, The Illinois Department of Public Health, and local public health departments due to the Coronavirus crisis. Federal agencies have largely deferred to States and local governments. The guidance has often been unclear, inconsistent, and changes

daily. This session will discuss how the guidance can be used as a defense to potential claims arising in connection with the Coronavirus pandemic.
